Report of the International Law Commission on the work of
its twelfth session (A/4425) (continued)

1. The CHAIRMAN pointed out that the USSR representative was the only speaker on his list and said that, in view of the few members present, it might be better to adjourn the meeting. In that connexion, he drew the Committee's attention to rule 110 of the rules of procedure under which a quorum of one-third of the members was required for a proper discussion.

2. After an exchange of views between the CHAIRMAN, Mr. MOROZOV (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) and Mr. VALLAT (United Kingdom), the CHAIRMAN suggested adjournment of the debate until the following meeting, which would be held on 17 October instead of on 13 October, as had been scheduled, in order that those who wished to speak might have time to prepare their statements.

It was so decided.
