We have the honour to inform you that today the Governments of Belize and the Republic of Seychelles have issued a joint communique concerning the establishment of diplomatic relations between the two countries, the text of which is as follows:

"The Governments of the States of Belize and the Republic of Seychelles desirous of promoting a spirit of mutual understanding and of developing ties of friendship and co-operation between their respective peoples, agreed to establish formal diplomatic relations, at non-resident Ambassadorial level with effect from November 20, 1991".

We would request Your Excellency to circulate this communication as a United Nations document, and we take this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency, the assurances of our highest consideration.
