SEIZURE OF 1KG 250 CR. HASHISH MADE AT KANTARA ON 25 MARCH 1947 Report Communicated by the Government of Egypt on 28 July 1947

Note by the Secretary-General

In accordance with Article 23 of the Convention for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs of 13 July 1931, as amended by the Protocol of 11 December 1946, the Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the following report on the above mentioned seizure to the Members of the United Nations and to the other parties to the Convention.

SEIZURE OF 1.250 KILOGRAMMES OF HASHISH AT KANTARA ON 25 MARCH 1947

(Case of IBRAHIM ALI IBRAHIM DARWISH)

On 25 March 1947, when IBRAHIM ALI IBRAHIM DARWISH who just arrived at Kantara by the East train from Rafah on his way to his village in Upper Egypt, was passing through the Customs zone, he was searched and found in possession of I.250 kilogrammes of hashish hidden under his clothes.

On interrogation, he stated that he had bought the seized drug from unknown person for his personal use.

On 12 June 1947 the accused was tried by the Summary Native Court, Kantara and sentenced to one year's imprisonment and a fine of L.E.200. (USA\$826).

The source of origin of the drug seized is unknown.
