GOVERNMENT OF ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

November 28, 1990

Excellency,


I have the honour to inform you that the Governments of Antigua and Barbuda and of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea have today issued simultaneously a joint communique concerning the establishment of diplomatic relations between both countries, the text of which follows:

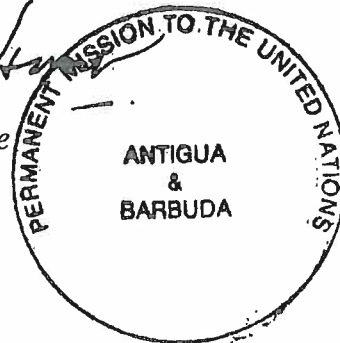
"With the desire to develop the relations of friendship and co-operation which exist between the Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the Government of Antigua and Barbuda,

On the basis of the principles of complete equality, mutual benefit and respect for sovereignty, and non-interference in the internal affairs of states, and in accordance with accepted principles of international law,

The Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the Government of Antigua and Barbuda have agreed to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level, non-resident, on the 27th November, 1990."

I would request Your Excellency to circulate this communication as a United Nations document, and I take this opportunity to renew to you the assurances of my highest consideration.
