Excellency,


We have the honour to inform you that as of August 9, 1990 diplomatic relations have been established between the Governments of the Hellenic Republic and the Republic of Namibia.

JOINT COMMUNIQUE


The Governments of the Hellenic Republic and of the Republic of Namibia, desirous to develop close relations of friendship and cooperation for the mutual benefit of their two peoples, and guided by the provisions of the Charter of the United Nations and the principles of international law, particularly the equality among nations and the respect for independence, national sovereignty, territorial integrity, non-interference, and promotion of international peace and security, have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the ninth of August nineteen ninety, at ambassadorial level.
