Excellency,

We have the honour to inform you that the Governments of Antigua and Barbuda and of the Democratic and Popular Republic of Algeria have today issued simultaneously a joint communique concerning the establishment of diplomatic relations between our two countries, the text of which follows:

"With a view to strengthening the ties of friendship and cooperation which exist between the Peoples and Governments of the Democratic and Popular Republic of Algeria and Antigua and Barbuda;

On the basis of the principles enshrined in the United Nations Charter and the authentic principles of the Non-Aligned Movement and in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic relations of 18 April, 1961;

The Government of the Democratic and Popular Republic of Algeria and the Government of Antigua and Barbuda have agreed to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries at non-resident Ambassadorial level effective on First November, 1989."

We would request Your Excellency to circulate this communication as a United Nations document, and we take this opportunity to renew to you the assurances of our highest consideration.
