CORRECTION TO DEFINITIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL TRADE STATISTICS

(Memorandum prepared by the Secretary-General)

The part of paragraph 17 beginning "For exports" should read: "For exports

- (i) Special exports include only exports of domestic merchandise, namely goods wholly or partly produced or manufactured in the country together with exports of nationalized goods.
 (Nationalized goods are goods which, having been included in special imports, are then exported.)
- (ii) General exports are the combined total of special exports and re-exports of imported merchandise including withdrawals from bonded warehouse or free zone for re-export."
