MR. CERAUD: DRAFT RESOLUTION

THE SUB-COMMISSION ON FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND THE PRESS

REQUESTS the Secretary-General to comply with the following directives regarding the documentation required for the session of April 1950:

- 1.- In order to obviate any unnecessary duplication of the researches and enquiries already carried out by UNESCO, the Section on Freedom of Information and the Press of the Secretariat shall apply itself principally to the collation of governmental measures, administrative, legislative and judicial, affecting freedom of the press and information and enacted subsequent to 1 January 1948;
- 2.- The Section on Freedom of Information and the Press shall be prepared, if necessary, to supplement the researches and enquiries carried out by UNESCO by researches and enquiries conducted under its own responsibility;
- 3.- The Section on Freedom of Information and the Press of the Secretariat shall undertake a detailed study of existing treaties relating to information and the press and shall collect full data concerning the eventual application of the two conventions, the conclusion of which is envisaged in the near future.
