

## COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS

SUB-COMMISSION ON THE PREVENTION OF  
DISCRIMINATION AND PROTECTION OF MINORITIES

PROPOSALS SUBMITTED BY MR. McNAMARA (AUSTRALIA) FOR ARTICLES TO BE INCLUDED IN A DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS, AND A CONVENTION ON HUMAN RIGHTS.

I. That the following Article be placed at the beginning of the proposed Declaration of Rights:

"In these Articles where the following words are used: "no one", "everyone", "all men", "all" (in the sense of all men), "each" (in the sense of each person), "any individual" or where other words are used in the same sense, then the following phrase shall be read in conjunction therewith:

"without distinction of any kind such as race, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, property status, national or social origin."

II. That the following Article be placed at the beginning of the proposed Convention on Human Rights:

"Where the following words are used: "any person", "no person", "no one", "every person", or where other words are used in the same sense, that the following phrase shall be read in conjunction therewith:

"without distinction of any kind such as race, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, property status, national or social origin."
