
Excellency,


We have the honour to inform Your Excellency that as from 17 December 1987, diplomatic relations between the Government of the Republic of Guyana and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand have been established and both Governments agreed to exchange diplomatic representatives at Ambassadorial level.

It was agreed that the establishment of such relations would, in the first instance, be at the level of non-resident accreditation.

We, therefore, kindly request Your Excellency to transmit this communication for the information of the Member States.
