AGREEMENT ON ESTABLISHING DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN
THE KINGDOM OF BHUTAN AND THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA

New York September 24, 1987

In view of the rapidly growing friendly and cooperative relations between the two countries and in
an earnest desire to further strengthen the relationship
based upon the principles and objectives of the Charter
of the United Nations, the Government of the Kingdom of
Bhutan and the Government of the Republic of Korea agree
hereby to establish diplomatic relations between the two
countries at the Ambassadorial level, effective today.
