
In view of the rapidly growing friendly and co-operative relations between the two countries and in an earnest desire to further strengthen the relationship based upon the principles and objectives of the Charter of the United Nations, the Government of the Kingdom of Bhutan and the Government of the Republic of Korea agree hereby to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries at the Ambassadorial level, effective today.

The two Governments will appoint their respective Ambassadors at a later date through consultation.
