


We have the honour to present our compliments to you and to request your kind assistance in having the attached document circulated among the Member States of the United Nations.

JOINT COMMUNIQUE



On the basis of the principles enshrined in the United Nations Charter and the authentic principles of the Non-Aligned Movement and in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic relations of 18 April 1961 ;

The Government of the Democratic and Popular Republic of Algeria and the Government of the Republic of Vanuatu have agreed to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries at the Ambassadorial level effective on July 15th, 1986.


