"Joint Communique on the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between the Mongolian People's Republic and the Kingdom of Lesotho

The Government of the Mongolian People's Republic and the Government of the Kingdom of Lesotho, desirous of maintaining and developing friendly relations between the peoples of Mongolia and Lesotho, have decided to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries at Ambassadoral level as of 2 July 1985."
