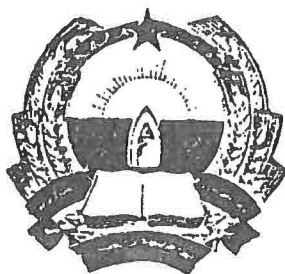

JOINT COMMUNIQUE BETWEEN THE
DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF AFGHANISTAN
AND THE
PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF MOZAMBIQUE

Acting on the basis of the desire of the two nations
for friendship and co-operation,

Reiterating their mutual commitment to the purposes
and principles of the United Nations Charter and policy of
non-alignment,

Desirous of having mutual relations based, inter alia,
on the principles of respect for sovereignty, territorial
integrity and national independence, non-interference in
the internal affairs of states, struggle against imperialism,
colonialism, neo-colonialism, apartheid and racism, including
Zionism, foreign domination and exploitation and for peace,
progress and social justice in the world,

The Government of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan
and the Government of the People's Republic of Mozambique
have agreed to establish diplomatic relations between the two
countries at the Ambassadorial level.

Accordingly, this joint communique was signed today,
January 7, 1985 in New York by the Ambassadors and Permanent
Representatives of the two friendly countries to the United
Nations.

Excellency,


