

JOINT COMMUNIQUE

In order to ensure the greater development of friendly relations between the Governments of the Republic of Venezuela and the Sultanate of Oman, to promote co-operation in areas of common interest and for the benefit of the two countries, and to act jointly in support of peace in the international community, in accordance with the purposes and principles established in the United Nations Charter and with reference to the relevant provisions of the Vienna Convention that regulate diplomatic relations between states, the Governments of Venezuela and the Sultanate of Oman have decided to establish as from this Monday, 29 September 1986, diplomatic relations between the two countries.
