PART XI OF THE RAPPORTEUR'S IRAFT REPORT TO THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL CONCERNING THE COMMITTEE ON ORGANIZATION

- During the Commission's discussion of the first reports from its Sub-Commissions, and especially in connection with the Commission's discussion concerning its own future work as well as the future work of its Sub-Commissions, the Commission felt that a proper consideration of these future activities involved a review of the experience to date under the existing terms of reference and creativational structure. The Commission therefore agreed to establish under Rule 19 of the rules of procedure of functional commissions a Committee on Organization consisting of the members of the Commission from Brazil, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Canada, China, France, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom and the United States of America.
- The Committee will be expected to report to the fourth session of the Commission its suggestions concerning the future organization and terms of reference of the Commission and its two Sub-Commissions. The Committee is requested to take into consideration the views expressed on this matter by the members of the Commission during the third session (see the Summary Records of the debate contained in documents E/CN.1/SR.54 and 55, and document E/CN.1/W.31).
- The Commission agreed that the functioning of this Committee should not 3. involve any additional expenditures by the United Nations, and that this Committee should therefore have one meeting during the third session of the Commission for the purpose of organizing its work. It was also agreed that, between the third and fourth sessions of the Commission, the work of the Committee should be carried on by correspondence. In that connection, the members of the Commission who are not on the Committee are urged to communicate during that time their views on this matter to the Secretariat so that it may circulate them to the members of the Committee.
- The Secretariat is requested to assist the Committee in circulating the materials prepared by individual members of the Committee and in preparing any other materials which the Committee members may require in their work.
