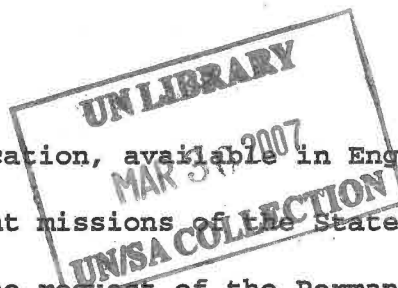


Excellency,

ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS  
BETWEEN  
THE GOVERNMENT OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA  
AND  
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL DEMOCRATIC  
REPUBLIC OF  
ETHIOPIA**

The Government of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Government of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia:

**Desiring** to promote and strengthen relations between the two countries and their people on the basis of equality, sovereignty, independence, territorial integrity and non-interference in each other's internal affairs;


**Committed** to strengthening friendly relations between the two countries and developing bilateral cooperation in different fields of mutual concern;

**Guided** by the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and the Vienna convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961;

**Have agreed** to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level with effect from the date of signature of the present Agreement.

**In witness thereof**, the undersigned plenipotentiaries, being duly authorized thereto their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement in two originals in the English language.
