Resolution adopted by the Commission on 18 May 1950

The Commission on the Status of Women

Considering the plight of women survivors of concentration camps who were subjected during the Nezi regime, to so-called medical experiments,

Requests the Economic and Social Council to call the attention of the Social Commission, the World Health Organization, or other appropriate agencies to the plight of these war victims who were compelled by force to reside in Germany during the wer, or at least those who may be unable to obtain compensation from any other country, and to keep the Commission on the Status of Women informed of any action taken in respect thereto.
