

Excellency,


We have the honor to inform that the Government of the Republic of Djibouti and the Government of the Republic of Fiji have established diplomatic relations as of 16 September 2010.

Desiring to promote mutual understanding and consolidate relations of friendship and cooperation between their respective peoples and countries,






