JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF TUVALU AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE GAMBIA

The Government of Tuvalu and the Government of The Gambia,

Desirous to promote mutual understanding and strengthen friendship and cooperation between the two countries,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the United Nations Charter and international law, particularly the respect and promotion of international peace and security, equality among States, due respect for national sovereignty and territorial integrity, independence and international treaties, and non-interference in internal affairs of States.

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communiqué.

In witness whereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorised by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in the English language.
