

## JOINT COMMUNIQUE

## on the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between Turkmenistan and the Republic of the Gambia

The Government of Turkmenistan and the Government of the Republic of the Gambia,

Guided by the mutual desire to initiate and develop friendship and cooperation between the two States in political, trade, economic and other fields,

Have decided, based on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961, to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level as the date of the signing of this Joint communique.

The relations between the two States will be based on the principles and norms of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, particularly, equality, respect for independence, national sovereignty, territorial integrity and noninterference in the internal affairs of each other.

The Government of Turkmenistan and the Government of the Republic of the Gambia are fully convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations will facilitate the cooperation and strengthen the peace.

In witness thereof, the undersigned, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint communique in Turkmen and English languages in two originals, all texts being equally authentic.
