LIST OF NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS PARTICIPATING
IN THE ACTIVITIES OF UNCTAD

Addendum

- 1. The Trade and Development Board, at the first part of its forty-first session, on 20 September 1994, took note that there were no new applications from non-governmental organizations for designation under rule 77 of the Board's rules of procedure.
- 2. At this session, the Board approved the recommendation of the Office-in-Charge of UNCTAD that Public Services International (PSI), a non-governmental organization which had been granted status in the special category at the first part of the fortieth session of the Board to participate in the work of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Comparative Experiences with Privatization, be reclassified in the General Category, in accordance with paragraph 12 (a) of Board decision 43 (VII), in order to enable the organization to participate in the work of other intergovernmental bodies of UNCTAD in which it had expressed interest.
- 3. The Board took note that, following consultation with the member State concerned (Spain), the Officer-in-Charge of UNCTAD had included the Foundation for the Promotion of Automated Information (FUINCA) in the Register of national non-governmental organizations provided for under Board decision 43 (VII), sections III and IV.
- 4. The Board noted that the World Assembly of Small and Medium Enterprises (WASME), a non-governmental organization which had been granted status by the Board at its thirtieth session, would henceforth be known as the World Association for Small and Medium Enterprises, retaining the same acronym.
- 5. The total number of non-governmental organizations included in the list provided for in rule 77 of the rules of procedure remains at 162: 76 in the <u>General Category</u> and 86 in the <u>Special Category</u>. The number of national non-governmental organizations included in the <u>Register</u> now totals 6.
