Excellency,

We have the honour to inform you that on 23 July 1987 the Governments of Jamaica and the Republic of Vanuatu simultaneously published a joint communique regarding the establishment of diplomatic relations. The text reads as follows:

"The Government of Jamaica and the Government of the Republic of Vanuatu have held consultations on the formal establishment of diplomatic relations between the two countries. These consultations resulted in exchange of Notes between His Excellency Robert F. Van Lierop, Chargé d'Affaires, a.i. of the Republic of Vanuatu to the United Nations, and His Excellency Lloyd M.H. Barnett, Permanent Representative of Jamaica to the United Nations. Both countries re-emphasized their adherence to the principles of the Charter of the United Nations and agreed to the establishment of resident or non-resident Missions when the circumstances allow."
