BUDGET ESTINATES FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 1953

Korean service medals

(Revised estimates for section 5 (Investigations and Inquiries))

Thirteenth report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions to the seventh session of the General Assembly

- 1. The Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions has considered a report by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/509) submitting revised estimates for section 5 in respect of the supply during 1953 of Korean service medals and ribbons, which were authorized by the General Assembly in resolution 483 (V) of 12 December 1950.
- 2. Due to a shortage of materials, it will not be possible to make full delivery during 1952 of orders placed under the existing contract. Consequently, the proposed 1953 provision of \$429,000 includes an unspent balance (\$174,500) of the 1952 appropriation.
- 3. The Advisory Committee considers that, since similar unavoidable delays during 1953 are likely to limit the volume of expenditure, the sum of \$300,000 should be provided in the 1953 budget, and that, if required, the balance of \$129,000 should be financed out of the Working Capital Fund. The Committee has been informed that the Secretary-General concurs in this view.
- 4. A further assurance was given to the Committee on behalf of the Secretary-General that, in view of the sharp increase in prices quoted, alternative sources of supply will be carefully explored before the letting of a new contract.
- 5. The Advisory Committee accordingly recommends an appropriation of \$300,000 under section 5 of the 1953 budget in respect of Korean service medals, and that

advances from the Working Capital Fund not exceeding \$129,000 in total should be authorized for the purposes indicated in the Secretary-General's report (A/C.5/509 6. The provisional appropriation already recommended by the Advisory Committee 1/for section 5 as a whole amounts to \$2,000,000. The estimates in document A/C.5/509 are the first of a series to be submitted as detailed justification for this tentative figure.
