PROGRESSIVE DEVELOPMENT OF INTERNATIONAL LAW AND ITS EVENTUAL C. DIFICATION

AMENDMENT SUBMITTED BY THE DELEGATION OF EGYPT TO THE DRAFT RESOLUTION PROPOSED BY THE DELEGATION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (A/C.6/137)

The Delegation of Egypt supports the draft resolution proposed by the United States of America, with the following amendments:

1. The International Law Commission to consist of fifteen members.

2. The words "and not more than two of whom may be non-nationals of the nominating States" in paragraph 2 of the draft Resolution to be deleted as being superfluous.

3. A paragraph to be added requesting the Commission to draw up in the first instance:

(a) a draft declaration of the rights and duties of States.

(b) a draft aimed at formulating the principles recognized in the Charter of the Nuremberg Tribunal and in the Judgment of that Tribunal.
