PROGRESSIVE DEVELOPMENT OF INTERNATIONAL LAW AND ITS EVENTUAL
CODIFICATIONAMENDMENT SUBMITTED BY THE DELEGATION OF EGYPT TO THE DRAFT RESOLUTION
PROPOSED BY THE DELEGATION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (A/C.6/137)

The Delegation of Egypt supports the draft resolution proposed by the United States of America, with the following amendments:

1. The International Law Commission to consist of fifteen members.
2. The words "and not more than two of whom may be non-nationals of the nominating States" in paragraph 2 of the draft Resolution to be deleted as being superfluous.
3. A paragraph to be added requesting the Commission to draw up in the first instance:
 - (a) a draft declaration of the rights and duties of States.
 - (b) a draft aimed at formulating the principles recognized in the Charter of the Nuremberg Tribunal and in the Judgment of that Tribunal.
