QUESTION OF THE COMPOSITION OF THE RELEVANT ORGANS OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Report of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee)

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 23 September 1994, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its forty-ninth session the item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations" and to allocate it to the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee).

2. At its 7th meeting on 18 October 1994, the Fourth Committee, on the proposal of the Chairman, decided to defer consideration of the item until the fiftieth session of the General Assembly and recommended its inclusion in the provisional agenda of that session.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPECIAL POLITICAL AND DECOLONIZATION COMMITTEE (FOURTH COMMITTEE)

3. The Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee) recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

The General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Special Political and Decolonization Committee (Fourth Committee), decides to defer consideration of the item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations" until its fiftieth session and to include it in the provisional agenda of that session.
