

JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF LATVIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF CAMEROON

The Republic of Latvia and the Republic of Cameroon,

With the purpose to promote mutual understanding, to strengthen the existing friendship and to promote co-operation among their two countries and peoples,

Reaffirming their commitment to the principles and purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, in particular the principles of mutual respect of equality among States, sovereignty, political independence, international treaties, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of another State, as well as of promotion of international peace and security,

Acting in accordance with the 1961 Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations and the 1963 Vienna Convention on Consular Relations,

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations among the two countries as of the date of the signature of this Joint Communiqué.

In witness thereof, the undersigned representatives, duly authorised by their respective Governments, have signed this Joint Communiqué in two originals in Latvian, English and French languages, all three texts being equally authentic.
