"The Committee of the League for the Rights of Man of the Congo and Ruanda-Urundi, which warmly approved the UNESCO proposals for the organization of additional nine-month courses of study for the indigenous inhabitants of these territories, vigorously protests against the unreasonable decision of the Belgian Government to refuse to permit such courses.

"The Committee, which can only bow before this decision in so far as it affects the Congo, respectfully requests the Trusteeship Council, as the authority responsible for the administration of Ruanda-Urundi, to take the initiative, in conjunction with UNESCO, in organizing such courses in these two territories.
