Letter dated 15 April 1993 from the Permanent Representative of Croatia to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

On 29 June 1992, the Republic of Croatia, pursuant to the Constitutional Decision of 25 June 1991 on sovereignty and independence, informed the Government of the United States of America, in its capacity as depositary of the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons, that, as one of the successor States to the former Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, it accepts the Treaty and undertakes to abide by the stipulations contained therein.

Upon instructions of my Government, I have the honour to inform you that the Republic of Croatia associates itself entirely with the joint statement of the Governments of the Russian Federation, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America as depositaries of the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (S/25515, annex). The Republic of Croatia expresses concern at the decision of the Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea to withdraw from the Treaty.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as an official document of the General Assembly, under item 71 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
