Statement by the European Community of 14 April 1993 on Malawi

The European Community and its member States have noted with satisfaction that the Government of Malawi and other parties, including those advocating multi-party democracy, reached an agreement on 6 April 1993 on the composition of the Referendum Commission. The Community and its member States have therefore decided to send a Joint EC Observer Mission to monitor the voter registration process within the common framework established by the United Nations.
