### I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 23 September 1994, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its forty-ninth session the item entitled "Social development, including questions relating to the world social situation and to youth, ageing, disabled persons and the family" and to allocate it to the Third Committee.

2. The Committee considered the item at its 9th to 11th, 13th to 15th, 17th, 22nd, 24th, 35th and 44th meetings, on 19, 20 and 31 October and on 1, 2, 8, 9, 17 and 28 November 1994. An account of the Committee's discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.3/49/SR.9-11, 13-15, 17, 22, 24, 35 and 44).

### II. CONSIDERATION OF THE PROVISIONAL RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR THE WORLD SUMMIT FOR SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

3. At its 44th meeting, on 28 November, the Committee had before it the provisional rules of procedure for the World Summit for Social Development (A/C.3/49/4/Rev.1 and Corr.1, annex).
