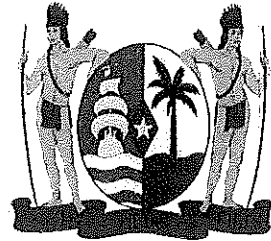

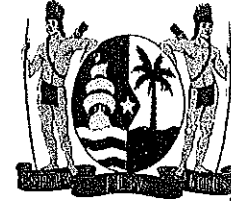

**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN**

THE GOVERNMENT OF NEPAL AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SURINAME

The Government of Nepal and the Government of the Republic of Suriname;

Desirous to promote mutual understanding and strengthen friendship and cooperation between the two countries;

Guided by the principles and purposes of the United Nations Charter and international law, particularly the respect and promotion of international peace and security, equality among States, due respect for national sovereignty and territorial integrity, independence and international treaties, and non-interference in internal affairs of States,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level with effect from the date of signature of the present Joint Communiqué, under the terms of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, and the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations of 24 April 1963.

In witness whereof, the undersigned Representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed the Joint Communiqué in duplicate, in the Nepali, Dutch and English languages, the three texts being equally authentic.
