PETITION FROM MR. MARCOUS MODI CONCERNING THE
CAMEROONS UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

SANTA, 13 December 1956

To the Secretary-General of the Trusteeship Council (United Nations), New York

Sir,

The incident at SANTA, at exactly 2 a.m. on the night of 12 December 1956.

Office of UPC BURNED.

Bring pressure to bear on the British Government and inquire why the UPC office at SANTA was deliberately burned on the night of 12 December 1956 at exactly 2 a.m. All the supplies and office equipment were burned to cinders.

We are now living like animals in the bush. Even animals live better than we do now that all the UPC offices have been burned. This is the third time (that such fires have occurred) in the BRITISH zone.
