LETTER DATED 15 APRIL 1993 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVES OF CAPE VERDE, DJIBOUTI, MOROCCO, PAKISTAN AND VENEZUELA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

We the members of the Non-Aligned caucus in the Security Council request you, in accordance with Article 2 of the Provisional Rules of Procedures of the Security Council, to convene an urgent meeting of the Security Council to discuss the deteriorating situation in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina. In this connection, two draft resolutions 1/ contained in documents S/25558 dated 8 April 1993 and S/25558* dated 12 April 1993 are already before the Council.

We request Your Excellency to circulate this letter as a document of the Security Council.
