We the population of Tombel Cameroon under British Administration held a meeting here today the 14th May 1955 to examine the condition of situation of our country. We see Tombel has no water supply, no hospitals, and no better schools. The Customs which English Govt. has kept in the country is giving us a lot of troubles. They do not allow us to smoke nor to sell our crops from our farms. In Tombel we have no motor roads and yet the Govt. says that any person will pay an amount of £5 from the farmers will be paid to every body who sells his cocca worth 1 ton. We have refused this bad treatment from the Govt. or the English Govt. We the population of Tombel have agreed for the (proclamation comun) We are waiting for the visiting of the United Nation Mission for the Unification and Independance immediately.
