Sir,

We have the honour most respectfully to inform you that, we here the population of Peng under British administration have held a meeting today on the 15th May 1955. To examine the condition and situation of our country.

A. We see that here in Peng farmers are suffering for motor road, no better way of selling crops such as coffee, bananas, cocoyams, plantains and cocoa, for better price. (b) The British Government said that any person who sells a ton of cocoa should pay £5 as a Government share. So we have refused this bad treatment from the Government. We the population of Peng have agreed for

the proclamation. We are waiting for the visiting of the United Nation Mission for the unification and independent immediately. (Reason of the penalty of customs)
