PETITION

Sirs,

We are in a great surprise to hear that as we were banned away from the french, the English europeens complained to people that they have given us jobs, to us in order to earn our living.

We terefore protest against it as stated bellow here; instead of them to receive us they only commissioned us to payd uncriminal fines and tax too, when all of us are suffering here without having lodging places and are not sure of our meal.

The franch have send our photos to the British to catch us and expatriate us back to french to our ennemy, e.g. the case of one of our cammrade SENDE JEAN Paul.

As well as many others are beeing cheased by police officers when we are out on propaganda. An established man pays tax fee of 16:6d, while unestablished reffuges politicans pay uncriminal fee of 1956, FSS0 Justin who paid 1956-after when he was beeing served two defferent receipt one indicating that tax 16 shillings on 6 pences and other indicating fine of court withott any crim on the reiept.

We forward here with our troubles here in the British Administering authority, when we have no house to lodge and are not sure of our meals, yet we pay

tax and punishment of our escepting the unfairness treatment of the French Authority.

We beg you then to ask the British men whe there they have abilishn the code law of Universal DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHT? If not abolised why should they say they have given us jobs where as they have not given us any job, thereby we wonder about without food and lodging places.
