HE SHOULD BE ACCOMPANIED BY A CAMEROONIAN

We have the honour to petition to you that we are not in favour of the representative in the U.N.O. for our Trust Territory (Southern Cameroons) being only a person of the Administering Authority (British).

This very person should be accompanied by a real Native of the Cameroons under British Administration who should be chosen or voted by the entire public.

Its needless hearing only from the British representative who is usually the Commissioner and an English man and will always speak in favour of Britain.

Hoping you will consider this point urgently.
