We are happy to inform you that the Southern Cameroons as a nation is ours. We consider ourselves as Africa and at the same time Free born of the Southern Cameroons. Our aim of puting this before you is this;

- We ask the United Nations to consider the Southern Cameroons: independent as soon as possible.
- II. We ask the United Nations to repeat the Northern Cameroons' Plebiscite, which took place on 11th February 1961.
