## PETITION FROM MR. TANE NAMA CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER BRITISH ADMINISTRATION

(Circulated in accordance with rule 85, paragraph 2 of the rules of procedure of the Trusteeship Council)

To the Secretary-General of the United Nations New York, U.S.A.

Sir,

I have the honour respectfully to inform you of the following:

We have been the victims of colonial repression in British Kamerun since the beginning of July 1959 until now, principally in the province of Bamenda and Kumba. Those two places are the centres for the arrest of political refugees and repatriation, harassment by the police etc.

To end these abuses, elections should be held to provide a good, constituent Kamerunian Government; otherwise nothing will go well.
