Sir,

We the above southern cameroons community will be grateful if we shall be allowed to tear our ballot papers because, we have rejected the two questions forced on us. We shall drop them to the ground, in the secret room.

Our party C.C.C. Cameroons Commoners Congress kneel down before you to take us away from the two Territorries forced on us, as the lord God divided the red sea into two parts.

We do not want the Nigerian Flag over our Heads. We want to sign an agreement with Britain to make our own National Flag, Compose our own National Anthem, build our own Broadcasting station, provide us with a mint for making money. Are you sure we shall be arrested or imprisoned, if we venture to tear the ballot papers or shall the torn ballot papers be Recorded? We do not want the Cameroons Republic Flag over our Heads.

Kindly reply us urgently before the plebiscite. This is our apeal.  
If possible we beg you to inform the members of the trustship council to make
