The great aim of the Summit Conf. at Mamfe where the natural rulers are failed in its objectives - Arriving at the questions to be asked during the Plebiscite. It is hoped that U.N. General Assembly will not fail to decide the questions to be put to the people during the plebiscite; whatever they may be. The questions to be asked should have a great deal to do with the end of whichever aim of the two parties. The questions have to be fair to all Parties (K.N.C./K.P.P. - K.N.D.P.). Dr. ENDELEY preached continued association with Nigeria when Nigeria becomes independent and the K.N.D.P. preached secession with re-unification with the French sector of the Cameroons.

Questions from all point of fairness, and considering the future prosperity of the territory should be:-

1. Do you wish continued association with Nigeria when she becomes independent or do you wish to secede and re-unify with the French sector of the Cameroons?

The question and its alternative are ... fair indeed to satisfy the aims of the two parties; by this also the future of the Territory will be determined.

I, the Fon of Kom wish you a free minded discussions, and guided decisions by God.
