Sir,

We support the decisions so far reached by our Premier Mr. Foncha and Dr. Endeley affecting our country that we second from Nigeria by 1st April, 1960, but we are opposed to any plebiscite before September, 1962. Sufficient time is required from date of secession and date of plebiscite.

Questions to be put must finally be decided in the 16th plenery session of the General Assembly.
