- 1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 23 September 1994, the General Assembly decided to include in the agenda of its forty-ninth session the item entitled "Administrative and budgetary coordination of the United Nations with specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. The Committee considered the item at its 31st meeting, on 9 December 1994. Comments and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/49/SR.31).
