LETTER DATED 5 MAY 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Today at 1700 New York time I spoke with the President of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Mr. Alija Izetbegovic. The President informed me of the continuing attack on the town of Zepa and of the tremendous suffering and casualties being experienced by the civilian population there.

President Izetbegovic stated that the fate of these people is now in the hands of the Security Council and he implored the Council to take whatever steps necessary to save Zepa and its people. The President requests the Security Council to respond to this plea tonight.

May I ask for your kind assistance in circulating this letter as a document of the Security Council.
