JS2 noted that, with the exception of tourists and non-citizens entering Mauritius for the purpose of marrying a citizen to whom they have disclosed their HIV status, no person living with HIV may enter Mauritius for the purpose of residence, work or study. It recommended reviewing the Immigration Act so that there are no mandatory medical tests and no results are used to refuse entry of non-Mauritians.⁷⁶
