The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has not reported any violations.

The Turkish representative office has reported 10 incidents of gunfire in the following Governorates: 5 in Hama, 3 in Ladhqiyyah and 2 in Idlib.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides and Refugee Migration Monitoring has carried out one humanitarian operation: in Tayhah, Dar'a Governorate, 500 food parcels with a total weight of 2.165 tons were distributed.

In total, 2,043 humanitarian operations have been carried out. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 3,221.208 tons.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

No ceasefire agreements have been signed over the past 24 hours.
