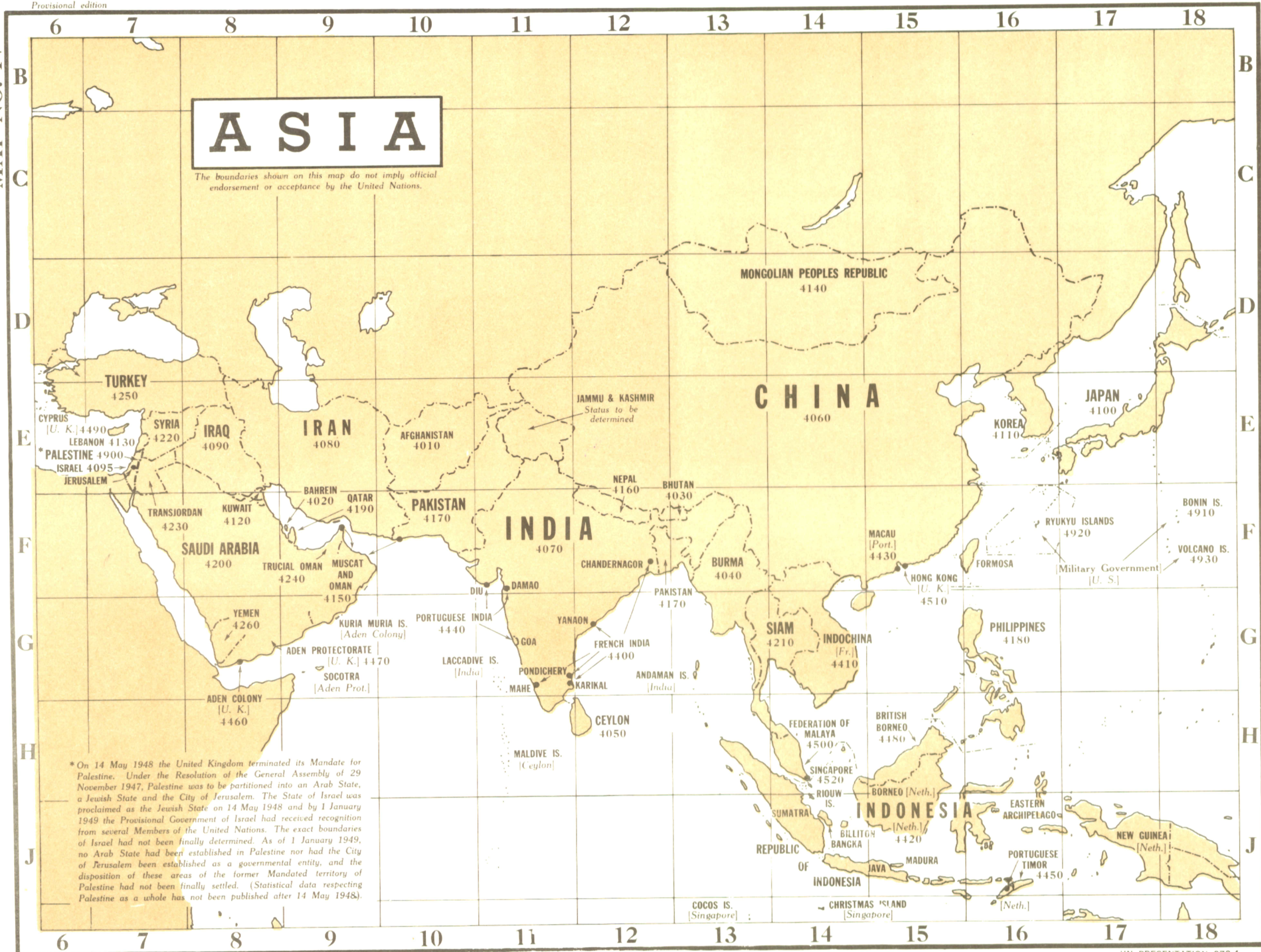

* On 14 May 1948 the United Kingdom terminated its Mandate for Palestine. Under the Resolution of the General Assembly of 29 November 1947, Palestine was to be partitioned into an Arab State, a Jewish State and the City of Jerusalem. The State of Israel was proclaimed as the Jewish State on 14 May 1948 and by 1 January 1949 the Provisional Government of Israel had received recognition from several Members of the United Nations. The exact boundaries of Israel had not been finally determined. As of 1 January 1949, no Arab State had been established in Palestine nor had the City of Jerusalem been established as a governmental entity, and the disposition of these areas of the former Mandated territory of Palestine had not been finally settled. (Statistical data respecting Palestine as a whole has not been published after 14 May 1948).
